5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend subsection (C) of Section  
7 35-4-17 ACLA 1949, relating to disposition  
8 of liquor license moneys; and declaring  
9 an emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

11 Section 1. Subsection (C) of Section 35-4-17 ACLA 1949 is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 (C) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS. All moneys collected or  
14 due the Territory for licenses under the provisions of this  
15 Act shall be deposited with the Territorial Treasurer;  
16 provided that the Treasurer shall refund semi-annually to  
17 incorporated cities and incorporated health districts all  
18 such moneys collected from within (THE) said incorporated  
19 (CITIES) areas (MAY BE REFUNDED SEMI-ANNUALLY TO THE SAID  
20 INCORPORATED CITIES; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN THE EVENT  
21 OF THE FAILURE OF THE OFFICERS OF SAID INCORPORATED CITIES  
22 TO ACTIVELY ENFORCE ALL OF THE ORDINANCES OF SAID  
23 INCORPORATED CITIES, THE LAW OF THE UNITED STATES, THE LAWS  
24 OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA AND THOSE REGULATIONS RELATIVE  
25 TO THE MANUFACTURE AND SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS IN THE  
26 TERRITORY OF ALASKA, THE TREASURER MAY DENY SAID REFUND AND  
27 NO FURTHER MONEYS WILL BE PAID TO SAID INCORPORATED CITIES  
28 UNTIL THE ENFORCEMENT OF SUCH LAWS AND REGULATIONS IS  
29 ACTIVELY RESUMED WITHIN SUCH MUNICIPALITIES).
