HOUSE BILL NO. 149

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the preparation, publication, and distribution of the journals of the Senate and House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Journals of the proceedings of the Senate and of the House of Representatives shall be prepared daily in mimeographed form by the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, respectively, during each session of the Legislature. Within ninety days after the close of every session, the Auditor shall cause to have published in printed and bound form at least two hundred copies of the journal of each house, including in the publications a proper index and a summary history of the action taken by the respective houses during the session.

Section 2. The Auditor shall furnish one copy of each journal to each member of the Legislature of which the journals are a record; to the Governor of the Territory of Alaska; to each of the District Judges, District Attorneys, and clerks of the court of the judicial divisions of the Territory; to the Attorney General and such other Territorial departments as may request them; two copies of each journal to the Territorial Library; and make such further distribution as may be necessary.
