HOUSE BILL NO. 161

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to create legislative districts in the First Judicial Division for election of members of the House of Representatives."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. There is established in the First Judicial Division, for the election of members of the House of Representatives, the following two legislative districts:

(a) District No. 1, which shall consist of the Skagway, Haines, Juneau and Sitka Recording Districts; and

(b) District No. 2, which shall consist of the Petersburg, Wrangell, Ketchikan and Hyder Recording Districts.

Section 2. At the general election to be held in 1954, and at each general election every two years thereafter, there shall be elected from each legislative district, by the qualified electors of such district, three members of the House of Representatives. All candidates for election from each legislative district shall be nominated by the qualified electors of such district at the primary election to be held in 1954, and at each primary election every two years thereafter, in the manner prescribed by the provisions of the primary election laws relating to the nomination of candidates for election to the legislature. A candidate for nomination or election from a particular legislative district must be a qualified elector in

such district.

Section 3. The term "Recording Districts" as used in Section 1 of this Act shall mean such districts as are now or as may hereafter be established by the district court under the provisions of Section 18-1-1 ACLA 1949.
