IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the regulation and
conduct of elections, amending
Section 38-5-20 ACLA 1949, and repealing
Sections 38-2-1 and 38-2-2 ACLA 1949."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Secretary of Alaska shall make rules and
regulations not inconsistent with the Territorial and political
subdivision election laws to facilitate the execution of their
provisions in an orderly and efficient manner and to that end
shall assist local election officers by devising uniform forms
and procedures.

Section 2. Section 38-5-20 ACLA 1949 is amended to read as
follows:

Section 38-5-20. FURNISHING FORMS, INSTRUCTIONS,
CONSTITUTION AND REGISTRATION OR POLL BOOKS; PREPARING
INSTRUCTIONS AND PRESCRIBING FORMS. At every general or
special election held in the Territory of Alaska, the clerk
of the District Court, or other officer whose duty it is to
furnish election supplies, shall furnish to the judges of
election of every voting precinct, a sufficient number of
forms for making the returns required by this Act
(Sections 38-5-2 - 38-5-30, 38-6-1 - 38-6-7 herein), and
shall also furnish printed copies of instructions to
voters, prepared by the (ATTORNEY GENERAL) Secretary of

1 Alaska, at least one printed copy of the Constitution of
2 the United States, as well as the registration or poll
3 books for the signatures of the voters, with his or her sex
4 and address. It shall be the duty of the (ATTORNEY GENERAL)
5 Secretary of Alaska to prepare a brief form of instructions
6 to voters, stating the manner of voting and the
7 qualifications of voters, as prescribed by the Act of
8 Congress of March 3, 1927, 44 Stat. 1392 (Sections 38-1-2-
9 38-1-9 herein), to prescribe the forms for the returns
10 required by this Act, and to furnish copies of such forms
11 to all officers whose duty it is to cause the same to be
12 printed and distributed.

13 Section 3. Sections 38-2-1 and 38-2-2 ACLA 1949 are
14 repealed.
