HOUSE BILL NO. 175

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 65-12-3 ACLA 1949, to prohibit the possession or carrying of weapons by convicts."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. That Section 65-12-3 ACLA 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 65-12-3. POSSESSION BY CONVICTS. No person who has been convicted of (A) ~~any felony~~ ^{with deleted} ~~or any misdemeanor involving assault, assault and battery,~~ ^{with deleted} ~~assault with a dangerous weapon,~~ BURG-LARY, ROBBERY AND LIKE CRIMES, (UNDER THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES, OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA, OR ANY STATE OF THE UNITED STATES, OR ANY OTHER GOVERNMENT OR COUNTRY) by any court in the Territory of Alaska, or by the courts of the United States or of any other state or territory, shall own or have in his possession or under his custody or control any pistol, revolver, or other firearm capable of being concealed (UPON THE) about his person, nor shall such person carry concealed about his person in any manner whatever any knife (other than an ordinary pocket knife), or any dirk or dagger, sling shot, metal knuckles, or any instrument by the use of which injury could be inflicted upon the person or property of any other person.
