HOUSE BILL NO. 182

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to leaves of absence for Territorial employees, and amending sub-section (a) of Section 11-5-6

AGLA 1949, ~~as amended by House Bill No. 182~~

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sub-section (a) of Section 11-5-6 AGLA

1949 is amended to read as follows:

(a) Annual Leave. Territorial employees shall be entitled to (TWO AND ONE-HALF (2½) WORKING DAYS) annual leave of absence with pay for each full month of service according to the following provisions:

- (1) Employees with less than <sup>two</sup> three years' service: one working day.
- (2) Employees with more than <sup>two</sup> three but less than <sup>ten</sup> ten years' service: one and one-half working days.
- (3) Employees with more than <sup>ten</sup> ten but less than <sup>ten</sup> fifteen years' service: two working days.
- (4) Employees with <sup>ten</sup> fifteen or more years' service: two and one-half working days.

Such leave may be taken by an employee at any time business permits, upon permission by the head of the department, office or agency for which such person works, and if such leave is not used in full during any one year, it shall accumulate, provided

1 that the total accumulation shall not exceed sixty working  
2 days. Terminal pay for unused leave shall be allowed upon  
3 separation from service, but no person accepting such pay  
4 shall be re-employed by any Territorial department, office  
5 or agency until after the expiration, following the separation,  
6 of the number of working days for which terminal leave pay  
7 was granted, unless an adjustment is made by cancelling leave  
8 not to be taken or returning that part of the terminal leave  
9 pay for which leave is not taken.  
10 Transfer from one Department to another will not affect earned  
11 terminal leave credits except as herein above provided.

*Section 2. This Act shall be effective from the date of its passage.*  
*This Act shall be April 1, 1953.*
