HOUSE BILL NO. 183

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Development Board; repealing Section 10-3-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 5, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, and ~~declaring an emergency.~~"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created the Alaska Development Board whose duty it shall be to carry out the purposes and provisions of Section 10-3-2 and 10-3-3 ACLA 1949. The Board shall consist of seven members, one of whom shall be a member at large, and of the other six, one shall be intimately associated with the fishing industry; one, with the mining industry; one with the construction industry; one, with an industry relating to the use of forestry products; one, with agricultural pursuits, and one, with the tourist and transportation business. All members shall be bona fide residents of Alaska. The members shall be appointed by the Governor with the consent and approval of the legislature in joint session assembled, the first appointments to be made as soon as possible after passage and approval of this Act. Terms of each member shall be for four years and until his successor is appointed and qualified, and the Governor shall fill any vacancy for an unexpired portion of a term, ⁶ provided that the initial term of the first three directors above named shall be for two years and the initial term of the remaining four directors shall be for four years. Rights and privileges of the

1 members with respect to travel, travel expenses, per diem and
2 compensation shall be identical with those provided by law
3 generally for members of other boards and commissions of the
4 Territory.

5 Section 2. Section 10-3-1 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter
6 5, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, is repealed.

7 Section 3. An emergency is declared to exist, and this
8 Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its
9 passage and approval.
