HOUSE BILL NO. 189

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to appropriate the sum of \$3,000,000.00 for school building construction and repair, and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA.

Section 1. The sum of \$1,500,000.00 or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the construction and repair of school buildings in areas outside Incorporated cities and Incorporated School Districts. This appropriation shall be used for all phases of the construction program including cost of plans, designs and specifications, and the necessary supervisory and inspection services.

Section 2. The sum of \$1,500,000.00, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the moneys in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the construction and repair of school buildings in city, independent, and incorporated school districts of Alaska on a grant-in-aid or matching fund basis. School districts that receive 75% Territorial refunds on operating expenses shall match 50¢ for each \$1.00 of Territorial money received under this Section; School districts that receive 80% refunds shall match 35¢ for each \$1.00 of Territorial money received hereunder; and school districts that receive 85% refunds shall match 10¢ for each \$1.00 of Territorial

1 funds received hereunder. The manner of calculating the amount
2 to be matched by each school district shall be as follows:
3 \$1,500,000.00 shall be divided by the total number of school
4 districts fully organized and incorporated on July 1, 1949 and
5 this quotient shall be the maximum amount of grant-in-aid to be
6 received by any one school district, provided, that any school
7 district which does not elect to obtain the maximum amount of
8 grant-in-aid may receive a lesser sum if matched in accordance
9 with the provisions of this Section.

10 Section 3. All school districts that have not applied for
11 a grant-in-aid under Section 2 on or before October 1, 1954
12 shall forfeit their right to such grants under this Act and the
13 funds remaining shall be available for distribution to the other
14 school districts in the manner provided in Section 2.

15 Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
16 this Act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and
17 approval.
