HOUSE BILL NO. 191

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of religious matter in the school system, and amending Section 37-1-14 ACLA 1949."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 37-1-14 ACLA 1949 is amended to read as follows:

Section 37-1-14. SECTARIAN OR DENOMINATIONAL DOCUMENTS AND DOCTRINES PROHIBITED. No books, papers, tracts, or documents of a partisan, sectarian or denominational character shall be introduced in any public school, and any and every partisan, sectarian or denominational doctrine(S) (ARE) is hereby expressly forbidden to be taught therein, and no teacher or school board shall receive any public money for the maintenance of schools which have not been conducted in accordance with the provisions of this section: Provided, that the reading of the Bible in its several versions shall not be excluded because of the provisions of this section.
