HOUSE BILL NO. 194

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 36-5-5, ACLA 1949, relating to power of Cemetery Associations to acquire and dispose of land."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 36-5-5, ACLA 1949, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

Provided that the provisions of the preceding section pertaining to the establishment of and to the expansion of an existing cemetery shall not be carried out without prior approval of the Alaska Board of Health. The Board of Health may, after proper investigation and hearings if deemed necessary, grant a permit to the cemetery association making application therefor, provided that it has been shown that such establishment or expansion does not create a public health nuisance and is in the best interests of the public.
