IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Chapter 82, Session Laws of Alaska 1949, as amended by Chapter 113, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, relating to a license tax on salmon canneries; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of Section 1 of Chapter 82, Session Laws of Alaska 1949, as amended by Chapter 113, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Salmon canneries, both shore based and floating: An annual license tax equal to (6 PERCENT) 5 percent of the value of the raw fish purchased or otherwise obtained for canning during the year. For the purpose of this license, such raw fish value of each kind of salmon shall be deemed to be a dollar value equal to 50 percent of the average wholesale price obtained for the finished product by principal canned salmon brokers in Seattle, Washington, during the months of August, September, October, November and December, of the license year.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval
