HOUSE BILL NO. 200

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the assembling, publication, and distribution of information concerning the administrative and clerical services of the Legislature and the rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives, <sup>and</sup> making an appropriation, <sup>"</sup> ~~and fixing an effective date.~~"

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Secretary of Alaska shall cause to be published for the benefit and use of the members of the Legislature information describing the administrative and clerical services of the Legislature and setting forth uniform practices and procedures for the performance of these services. For this purpose the Secretary is authorized to hire a competent person to compile and prepare the necessary information and to secure its publication and distribution in accordance with this Act.

Section 2. The Secretary of Alaska shall distribute to the members of the Legislature, not later than forty days before the convening of each regular session, a copy of the publication on administrative and clerical services herein provided for together with a copy of the Rules of the Senate and of the House of Representatives of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska.

2 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of

5 monies shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasury of the
