United States Government; and

WHEREAS, under present law the General Land Office does not

15

have authority to make over 160 acres available for patent; and

16

WHEREAS, some of these sites needed are in excess of 160

acres;

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the

19

Territory of Alaska, respectfully prays that Congress immedi-

20

ately authorize sale by the General Land Office, of sites in

21

excess of 160 acres needed for industrial plants, mills and

22

related uses.
