5 TO THE HONORABLE DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED

6 STATES; TO THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES; AND TO THE

7 HONORABLE E. L. BARTLETT, DELEGATE TO CONGRESS FROM ALASKA:

8 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of
9 Alaska, in Twenty-first Session assembled, respectfully submits

10 that:

11 WHEREAS, from time to time the Federal Government conducts
12 extensive studies for the purpose of reorganizing the various
13 agencies of the Federal Government; and

14 WHEREAS, several such studies and surveys have been made
15 of the Veterans Administration; and

16 WHEREAS, in at least one of these studies are included
17 recommendations which would greatly reduce the service to the
18 Veterans in the Territory of Alaska if adopted; and

19 WHEREAS, because of the size, geographical location, and
20 topography of Alaska, there are numerous problems arising quite
21 often in furnishing service to the veterans of the Territory
22 that are peculiar to Alaska;

23 NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the
24 Territory of Alaska in Twenty-first Session assembled, respect-
25 fully prays that Congress oppose any reorganization of the
26 Veterans Administration -- such as recommended by the Hoop,
27 Allen Hamilton Report which would eliminate the Regional Office
28 of the Veterans Administration in Alaska -- which would greatly
29 reduce service that is being furnished to veterans in Alaska

1 at the present time.
