

1. IN THE HOUSE BY COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS
2. HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1
3. IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
4. TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ALASKA
6. LEGISLATURE IN TWENTY-FIRST SESSION ASSEMBLED:

7. 1. That the sum of ¹⁵⁷\$157,610.00 or so much thereof as
8. shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any
9. monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not other-
10. wise appropriated for the payment of salaries to persons em-
11. ployed by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
12. Territory of Alaska during the present session, said sum to
13. be apportioned according to the following schedules:

14. (A) For the salaries of the Chief Clerk of the House of
15. Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate, \$26.00 per day
16. for 71 days, which includes 11 days service in preparation
17. of Journal; the Assistant Clerk of the House of Representa-
18. tives, \$21.00 per day for 71 days which includes 11 days
19. service in preparation of Journal; one Assistant Secretary
20. of the Senate, at \$21.00 per day for 71 days which includes
21. 11 days service in preparation of Journal; the sum of \$6,674.00

22. (B) For the salaries of the Sergeant-at-Arms of the
23. House of Representatives, \$18.00 per day for 60 days, and
24. the Sergeant-at-Arms of the Senate, \$18.00 per day for 60
25. days; the sum of \$2,160.00

26. (C) For the salaries of the following employees of the
27. Senate for 60 days: one Bill Clerk, one Engrossing Clerk, one
28. Enrolling Clerk, and four typists at \$17.00 per day; one
29. Judiciary Clerk, one Finance Committee Clerk, two stenographers

1. at \$19.00 per day; one mimeograph operator and two messengers
2. at \$16.00 per day, and one doorkeeper and one watchman at
3. \$15.00 per day; the sum of \$16,380.00

4. (D) For the salaries of the following employees of the
5. House of Representatives, for 60 days, one mimeograph operator
6. and one Mail and File Clerk, at \$16.00 per day; two messengers
7. at \$16.00 per day; two stenographers at \$19.00 per day; seven
8. typists at \$17.00 per day; one doorkeeper at \$15.00 per day;
9. the sum of \$14,160.00

10. (E) For the salaries of the Chaplain of the House of
11. Representatives, for 60 days at \$6.00 per day, and for the
12. Chaplain of the Senate, 60 days at \$6.00 per day, the sum of
13. \$ 720.00

14. 2. That the sum of \$400.00, is hereby appropriated out
15. of any monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not
16. otherwise appropriated for the payment of additional services
17. rendered by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of
18. the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska during
19. the regular session, and this money is to be equally divided.

20. 3. That the sum of \$3,450.00 or so much thereof as shall
21. be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in
22. the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropri-
23. ated for the payment of compensation to such janitors and char-
24. women as are necessary to clean, care for and keep in proper
25. order the rooms occupied by the legislature at this session.

26. 4. That the sum of \$66.00 or so much thereof as shall be
27. found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in
28. the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise
29. appropriated for the payment of necessary telephone service

1. for use of the Legislature during the present session.

2. 5. That the sum of \$55,000.00 or so much thereof as shall
3. be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in
4. the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropria-
5. ted for the payment of printing and binding of the Senate and
6. House Journals, Session Laws and advance sheets; and for printing
7. and furnishing stationery and other printing for the use of the
8. Legislature during the present session.

9. 6. That the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as shall
10. be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in
11. the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropria-
12. ted for the purchase of mimeograph paper, type writing paper,
13. stencils, carbons and such other material and supplies as may be
14. necessary for the use of the Legislature during the present
15. session.

16. 7. That the sum of \$50,000.00 or so much thereof as shall
17. be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies in
18. the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropria-
19. ted for the payment of per diem in lieu of subsistence at the
20. rate of \$20.00 per day for the members of the Legislature, 62
21. days each for regular members of both Houses and 71 days for
22. the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House.

23. 8. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated out
24. of the monies of the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not
25. otherwise appropriated, to be paid \$50.00 to each member of
26. the House and Senate, as the estimated amount necessary to
27. defray costs of mailing, telegraphing and otherwise communi-
28. cating with constituents during this session.

29. 9. That the sum of \$500.00, or so much thereof as shall
HJR No. 1 as amended by the Senate

1. be found necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any monies
2. in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appro-
3. priated to be used as a Contingent Fund. This fund to be
4. divided \$300.00 to the House of Representatives and \$200.00 to
5. the Senate for use in defraying costs of extra mailing of a
6. mass nature or other contingencies and same to be drawn on by
7. the authority of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
8. or President of the Senate, respectively.

9. 10. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Committee on Terri-
10. torial Offices and Institutions in the Senate and the Committee
11. on Territorial Institutions in the House of Representatives be
12. and they are hereby authorized and directed to provide for the
13. transportation of a committee from the Senate and a committee
14. from the House of Representatives from Juneau, Alaska, to Sitka
15. and return, said committees to inspect and examine the Pioneers'
16. Home at Sitka, Alaska, and report to the Legislature their
17. findings and recommendations. That for the purpose of defraying
18. the cost of transportation of said committee there is hereby
19. appropriated the sum of \$1,500.00, or so much thereof as may
20. be necessary, for such purpose.

21. 11. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the monies hereby appro-
22. priated shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Treasurer of
23. the Territory of Alaska upon vouchers approved by the President
24. of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

25. 12. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is hereby
26. declared to exist and this Resolution shall be in full force
27. and effect immediately upon its passage.
