IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

§ TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 TO HONOR THE MEMBERS ASSEMBLED IN THE FIRST SESSION OF THE

6 LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, on the third day of March, 1913, at Juneau, the
9 Capitol of Alaska, pioneer residents of the Territory assembled
10 as members of the First Regular Session of the Legislature of
11 the Territory of Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS, in that First Session eight members of the Senate
13 and fifteen members of the House of Representatives enacted
14 historic legislation which remains today a significant part
15 of the laws of Alaska; and

16 WHEREAS, it is fitting that Alaska's pioneer legislators
17 and their work should be honored by a suitable memorial in the
18 legislative halls of the territory:

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the
20 Territory of Alaska, in Regular Session assembled, that

21 1. A plaque bearing the names of the members of the first
22 Senate of Alaska and another bearing the names of the members
23 of the first House of Representatives of Alaska be purchased and
24 hung in the antechambers of the respective Houses.

25 2. A committee composed of the Speaker of the House as
26 chairman, one Representative appointed by the Speaker, and one
27 Senator appointed by the President of the Senate, is designated
28 to select and purchase the plaques and do everything else
29 necessary to accomplish the purposes herein states.

1 3. The sum of \$500.00, or so much thereof as may be
2 found necessary, is appropriated to carry out the provisions
3 of this Resolution, and the monies shall be paid by warrant
4 drawn on the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska upon a
5 voucher approved by the Speaker of the House and the President
6 of the Senate.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is declared to
8 exist and this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon
9 its passage and approval.
