2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION CONCERNING  
6 ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND PROCEDURES OF THE LEGISLATURE OF  
7 ALASKA.

8 WHEREAS, uniform practices and procedures in the  
9 administrative and clerical services of the Legislature of Alaska  
10 are desirable; and

11 WHEREAS, intimate knowledge of these services by all  
12 legislators is recognized as necessary to the efficient and  
13 expeditious conduct of the legislative process; and

14 WHEREAS, the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives of  
15 the Twenty-first Session of the Legislature, Mrs. Margaret  
16 Grisham, has had long and valuable experience with these services;

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the  
18 Territory of Alaska in Regular Session assembled, that

19 1. Information describing the administrative and clerical  
20 services of the Legislature and setting forth uniform practices  
21 and procedures for the performance of these services be assembled,  
22 published, and made available for distribution, together with  
23 a copy of the Rules of the Senate and House of Representatives  
24 as last adopted, to all legislators prior to their convening at  
25 any session.

26 2. Mrs. Margaret Grisham is hereby commissioned and  
27 authorized to compile and prepare the necessary information; to  
28 arrange for its publication and delivery to the Secretary of  
29 Alaska, who shall secure its distribution, together with the

1   aforementioned Rules, to all legislators not later than sixty  
2   days before the convening of the next session; and to take such  
3   further action as may be necessary to effect the purpose herein  
4   stated.

5       3. The sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_, or so much thereof as  
6   may be found necessary, is appropriated to carry out the  
7   provisions of this Resolution, and the monies shall be paid by  
8   warrants drawn on the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska upon  
9   vouchers approved by the Speaker of the House and the President  
10  of the Senate.

11       BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an emergency is declared to  
12  exist and this Resolution shall become effective April 1, 1953.

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
