18. Territory of Alaska; and

19. WHEREAS, the people of the Territory of Alaska are desir-  
20. ous of having an Alaskan appointed Governor of Alaska until  
21. such time as enabling legislation is enacted so that they may  
22. elect an Alaskan to this office; and

23. WHEREAS, there are residents of the Territory of Alaska  
24. who are able and fully qualified to fill the office of Governor;

25. NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representa-  
26. tives of the Territory of Alaska, respectfully urges that a  
27. bona fide resident and inhabitant of the Territory of Alaska  
28. be forthwith appointed to the office of governor.
