8 Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the
9 Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Session assembled, respect-
10 fully represents;

11 WHEREAS, the Palmer Municipal Airport is receiving in-
12 creasingly heavy use by private and commercial aviation
13 interests; and

14 WHEREAS, this airport is so located and is of such
15 character as to be an important emergency field for the heavy
16 civilian and military air traffic in the vicinity of Palmer and
17 Anchorage; and

18 WHEREAS, the usefulness of this airport would be signifi-
19 cantly increased if it were equipped for operations between
20 sunset and sunrise;

21 NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representa-
22 tives of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Session
23 assembled, respectfully urges the Alaska Aeronautics and Communi-
24 cations Commission and the Department of Aviation to provide for
25 the installation at the Palmer Municipal Airport of a rotating
26 beacon and boundary lights, approved by the Civil Aeronautics
27 Administration, on both the North-South and East-West runways
28 of the Airport.
