Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the
Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Session assembled, re-
spectfully represents:

WHEREAS, the existing provisions for the care of certain
juveniles as given in the Juvenile Code does not seem to pro-
vide adequately for the treatment of certain children; and

WHEREAS, the Territory of Alaska does not have in its
judicial system the facilities of a juvenile court which could
deal with youthful offenders; and

WHEREAS, it seems that the present judicial system of the
Territory of Alaska could provide such a Juvenile Court;

NOW THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the House of Representa-
tives of the Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Session
assembled, respectfully requests that the United States Dis-
trict Judges of the Territory of Alaska review the existing legal
structure as it pertains to juveniles and discuss with the
Circuit Judges as soon as possible the ways by which such a
Juvenile Court system could be enacted in the Territory of
Alaska.
