5 AN ACT

6 For an Act entitled: "Providing for the destruction of obsolete
7 records and papers, and repealing
8 Chapter 71, SLA, 1951."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. At the end of each biennium ending December 31,
11 and on even numbered years, the head of any territorial depart-
12 ment may destroy all vouchers, documents and other records and
13 papers on file that have been microfilmed; Provided, that ^{all} ~~all~~
14 records, papers, vouchers, receipts and other memorandum deal-
15 ing with fiscal matters of the Territorial Government shall not
16 be destroyed, even though they are microfilmed, until an official
17 audit has been made to the satisfaction of the Auditor.
18 Provided further that no record shall be destroyed which is
19 considered to be of permanent value and in current use.

20 Section 2. Chapter 71, SLA, 1951 is hereby repealed.
