5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to reimburse the Providence
7 Hospital, Anchorage, Alaska, for services
8 rendered certain indigents, deceased and
9 other persons; making an appropriation;
10 and declaring an emergency."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. The sum of \$26,290.90 is hereby appropriated
13 out of the moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not
14 otherwise appropriated, to reimburse the Providence Hospital,
15 Anchorage, Alaska, upon vouchers approved by the Territorial
16 Department of Public Welfare, for hospitalization and services
17 and materials in connection therewith furnished the following
18 named indigents, deceased and other persons, and not paid for
19 out of public relief funds or otherwise;
