7 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Sec. 37-2-5 ACLA 1949,
8 as amended by Ch. 34 S.L.A. 1951, relat-
9 ing to meetings of the Board of Education;
10 and declaring an emergency."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. That Sec. 37-2-5 ACLA 1949, as amended by
13 Ch. 34 S.L.A. 1951 is hereby amended to read as follows:

14 Sec. 37-2-5. MEETINGS OF BOARD AND NOTICE THEREOF:

15 QUORUM; VOTING. Regular meetings of the Board of Education
16 shall be held at the capital during regular sessions of the
17 Territorial Legislature. All other regular meetings shall
18 be held at such time and place in the Territory as may be
19 designated by the Board; provided, that special meetings
20 shall be called by the Commissioner of Education at the
21 written request of a majority of the members of the Board,
22 or may be called by the Governor on his own initiative,
23 at such places in the Territory as may be designated in
24 the call for the special meeting. Written or telegraphic
25 notice of all regular and special meetings of the Board
26 of Education shall be given to each member thereof at his
27 last known address at least fifteen (15) days prior to
28 the date of such meeting. The regular meetings of the
29 Board shall not last to exceed (TEN (10)) fifteen (15)

days, and a special meeting shall last not to exceed five (5) days. Three (3) members shall constitute a quorum but a less number may adjourn from day to day for a period not exceeding ten (10) days; provided, however, that no action may be taken or resolution or motion adopted by the Board unless at least three (3) affirmative votes are in favor thereof.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
