4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 37-3-62, of Alaska
7 Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949, as amended
8 by Chapter 77, Session Laws of Alaska,
9 1951, relating to the method of deter-
10 mining the amount of refund paid to City
11 School and Incorporated District Schools;
12 to modify Section 37-3-64 (c) Alaska
13 Compiled Laws Annotated, 1949, to the
14 extent necessary to pay such claims;
15 establishing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

17 Section 1. That Section 37-3-64, of Alaska Compiled Laws
18 Annotated, 1949, as amended by Chapter 77, Session Laws of Alaska,
19 1951, be amended to read as follows:

20 "Section 37-3-62. AMOUNT OF REFUND. Where the average
21 daily attendance for the last complete school year at the
22 time the budget is approved is less than 150 pupils,
23 eighty-five per centum and where it is 150 pupils or over
24 and less than 300, eighty per centum and where it is 300
25 pupils or over, seventy-five per centum of the total amount
26 expended for maintenance of public elementary schools and
27 high schools within the limits of incorporated cities or
28 incorporated school districts or independent school
29 districts shall be refunded to such city or school district

1 from the monies of the Territory appropriated for such
2 purposes. Provided however, that in addition to the
3 foregoing amount of refund, those cities or districts
4 who have within the said limits low-rent housing projects
5 owned, operated and constructed by the Alaska Housing
6 Authority or other Federal or Territorial agency claiming
7 an exemption from taxation, without the petition from or
8 consent by the said city or district for the construction
9 of said project, shall be entitled to the equivalent of
10 such sums otherwise lost or exempted in property taxes, but
11 from such sums shall first be deducted any amounts received
12 during the year as contributions in lieu of taxes made by
13 the exempted agency to the said city or district."

14 Section 2. Section 37-3-64 (c), Alaska Compiled Laws
15 Annotated, 1949, is hereby modified only to the extent necessary
16 for the payment of such claims to be paid under this Act.

17 Section 3. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1953.
