5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for hospital assistance
7 and/or furnishing necessary equipment for
8 municipalities, communities and
9 associations operating non-profit
10 hospitals; amending Sections 1, 2 and 3
11 of Chapter 81, Session Laws of Alaska
12 1949; and declaring an emergency."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. Section 1 of Chapter 81, Session Laws of Alaska
15 1949, is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1. The Territorial Board of Health is hereby
17 authorized to facilitate purchase, construction and repair
18 of, and/or obtain necessary equipment for, (COMMUNITY
19 OPERATED) municipalities, communities and associations
20 operating non-profit hospitals in the Territory of Alaska.

21 Section 2. Section 2 of Chapter 81, Session Laws of Alaska
22 1949, is amended to read as follows:

23 Section 2. The Territorial Board of Health shall
24 initiate appropriate action in conformity with the
25 provisions of this Act, as soon as said Board shall
26 determine which projects are of most immediate necessity,
27 and allot money hereunder to such municipalities,
28 communities and associations on a matching basis, or
29 otherwise in accordance with the financial ability of

(THE MUNICIPALITY) such municipalities, communities and
associations and ^{seriousness} seriousness of the need.

Section 3. Section 3 of Chapter 81, Session Laws of Alaska
1949, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Intent of this Act is to provide financial
aid to those municipalities (WHOSE REAL AND PERSONAL
TAXABLE VALUES ARE LIMITED IN SCOPE AND), communities and
associations for (WHOM) which any attempt at complete
financing (BY THE MUNICIPALITY) thereby of such necessary
project would entail great hardship. It is also intended
that the Board should utilize the money hereunder, so far
as can be arranged, to assist such municipalities,
communities and associations in matching funds with the
Federal Government or any of its departments or agencies
under any applicable Federal law for hospital assistance.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and
this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
approval.
