3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing construction of a  
7 Territorial office building at Anchorage,  
8 Alaska; making an appropriation; and  
9 declaring an emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. There is appropriated from the treasury moneys  
12 not in excess of \$1,250,000.00 for the purpose of acquiring a  
13 site, perfecting plans and constructing a Territorial office  
14 building at Anchorage, Alaska.

15 Section 2. The Board of Administration is authorized to  
16 direct and supervise the expenditure of moneys appropriated to  
17 carry out the provisions of this Act; to contract, on behalf of  
18 the Territory; to receive and expend moneys donated by private  
19 parties; to receive and expend funds made available by the  
20 Federal Government or by the City of Anchorage, and in the  
21 Board's discretion, to utilize such funds on a matching basis  
22 with moneys appropriated to carry out the provisions of this  
23 Act; to receive property and other aid and assistance from the  
24 City of Anchorage and to enter into negotiations and agreements  
25 for joint occupancy of such office building by the Territory and  
26 the City of Anchorage, provided that contributions on the part  
27 of such municipality, whether by way of funds, property or  
28 otherwise, shall not be less than those of the Territory, and  
29 that space allocated in such building for use of such

municipality shall not exceed that reserved for use by the Territory; and to do all other things that it may deem necessary to effectuate the provisions of this Act.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
