5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Motor
7 Vehicle Act; amending Sections 3(3) and 5
8 of Chapter 124, Session Laws of Alaska
9 1951; and declaring an emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Section 3 (3) of Chapter 124, Session Laws of
12 Alaska 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 (3) VEHICLES REGISTERED ELSEWHERE. Upon the
14 registration of every foreign vehicle subject to
15 registration under this Act, which has been registered
16 heretofore in any other state or country, the applicant for
17 registration under this Act shall surrender to the
18 commissioner all certificates or registration, or other
19 evidences of such former registration as may be in such
20 applicant's possession or control; provided, however, that
21 where in the course of interstate operation of a vehicle
22 registered in another state it is desirable to retain
23 registration of said vehicle in such other state, such
24 applicant need not surrender but shall submit for
25 inspection such evidences of such foreign registration, and
26 the commissioner upon a proper showing shall register said
27 vehicle in this Territory but shall not issue a certificate
28 of title for such vehicle. It is further provided that in
29 the event the registered or legal owner cannot surrender

1 the out-of-state title, or registration certificate in the
2 case of non-title states, because of encumbrances or
3 otherwise, the motor vehicle shall be registered in the
4 usual manner and the Alaskan registration certificate shall
5 be marked "No Alaska Title Issued".

6 Section 2. Section 5 of Chapter 124, Session Laws of Alaska
7 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 Section 5. CERTIFICATES OF TITLE. No vehicle subject
9 to registration under this act, except foreign vehicles
10 provided for in Section 3(3), shall be registered by the
11 department unless the applicant for such registration at the
12 same time makes application for and obtains an official
13 certificate of title of such vehicle, or shall present
14 satisfactory evidence that such certificate of title has
15 been previously issued to such applicant. With the
16 exception of foreign vehicles provided for in Section 3(3),
17 it shall be unlawful for any person to drive or move, or
18 for an owner knowingly to permit to be driven or moved,
19 upon any highway in the Territory any vehicle of the type
20 required to be registered hereunder for which a certificate
21 of title has not been issued.

22 Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
23 this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
24 approval.
