6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Aid to the Blind,  
7 increasing the maximum payment, amending  
8 Section 4, Chapter 126 S.L.A. 1951; and  
9 fixing an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Section 4, Chapter 126 S.L.A. 1951, is amended  
12 to read as follows:

13 Section 4. AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE. The amount of  
14 assistance which shall be granted for any needy blind  
15 person shall be determined by the Welfare Department with  
16 due regard to the resources and (NECESSARY) needs of the  
17 person, and the conditions existing in each case, and shall  
18 be sufficient to provide the applicant with reasonable  
19 subsistence compatible with decency and health, and  
20 according to Standards of Assistance established by the  
21 Welfare Department, but shall in no case exceed the rate  
22 of ( \$80.00 ) <sup>\$100.00</sup> ~~\$90.00~~ per month.

23 Section 2. This Act shall take effect April 1, 1953.
