IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize the Alaska Fisheries Board to accept money for specific purposes, to create a special "Fisheries Contingent Receipts Fund" for deposit of such money, and to provide for disbursement of moneys from the fund."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Alaska Fisheries Board, acting by and through its Director, is authorized to accept money from any person, firm, partnership, corporation, organization, or governmental agency, under conditions requiring the use of such money for specific purposes in furtherance of the protection, rehabilitation, preservation, or conservation of the territorial fish and shellfish resources, or in settlement of any claims for damages to such fish and shellfish resources.

Section 2. The Director of the Board is hereby designated the agent of the Territory to accept and receive all such funds and deposit them with the Territorial Treasurer who shall credit them to a special fund, which is hereby created in the Territorial Treasury, and to be known as the "Fisheries Contingent Receipts Fund."

Section 3. Whenever any money has been received and is to be spent for a specific purpose, the Director, with the approval of the Board, shall submit to the Governor triplicate copies of a

1 statement setting forth the facts regarding such funds and need
2 for such expenditures and the estimated amount to be expended.

3 If the Governor shall approve such estimate in whole or in
4 part, he shall endorse on each copy of such statement his
5 approval with the amount approved, and shall transmit one copy
6 of the same to the Territorial Treasurer and one copy to the
7 Director, authorizing the latter to make the expenditure. No
8 expenditure shall be authorized in excess of the actual amount
9 received, nor shall funds be expended for any purpose except the
10 specific purpose for which they were received, unless the same
11 were received in settlement of a claim for damages to the fish
12 and shellfish resources of the Territory, and in that event such
13 funds so received may be expended for the protection,
14 rehabilitation, preservation or conservation of such resources.

15 Section 4. Disbursements from the fund shall be paid by
16 the Territorial Treasurer on presentation of vouchers signed by
17 the Director of the Board and approved by the Auditor of Alaska.
