IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA
TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend Section 11-1-4 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 82, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, so as to exempt certain specialists from the citizen requirement for employment."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 11-1-4 ACLA 1949, as amended by Chapter 82, Session Laws of Alaska 1951, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11-1-4. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PROHIBITED. It shall be unlawful for the Territory of Alaska, or any municipality in the Territory of Alaska to employ at any rate of compensation as officer, agent, or servant, any person who is not a citizen of the United States, except that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to doctors, dentists, public health nurses, and technicians employed by the Alaska Department of Health, or to fishery biologists employed by the Alaska Department of Fisheries, provided however, that such persons shall have received their first papers, and shall actively pursue such application for citizenship, and shall have, before employment, taken and submitted to the oath provided for in Chapter 113 S.L.A. 1949 known as the non-Communist oath.
