TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to travel of Territorial  
officials and employees; amending  
subsection 3(c) of Section 11-4-1 ACLA  
1949; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsection 3(c) of Section 11-4-1 ACLA 1949 is  
amended to read as follows:

(c) Officials and employees traveling for the  
Territory may, upon the approval of the head of the office  
for which they are traveling, use their own conveyance, but  
reimbursement for the same shall not exceed (SEVEN (7))  
~~Twenty~~ <sup>Twelve</sup> cents per mile for actual travel. Where two or  
more employees are traveling in the same direction, on the  
same mission, and it is possible to share the convenience  
of a private conveyance, the mileage permitted shall be  
allowed only once.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and  
this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and  
approval.
