SENATE BILL NO. 93

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for the control of predatory animals, to authorize cooperation with the United States in the control of such predatory animals, and to provide funds for that purpose."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Territorial Treasurer is authorized and directed to cooperate with the United States Department of the Interior, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, in the control and destruction of wolves, coyotes and other predatory animals in this Territory in accordance with the organized and systematic plans of said U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and for this purpose to enter into written agreements with said U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service covering the methods and procedure to be followed in such control.

Section 2. All money appropriated to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be expended for equipment, materials, supplies, services or labor performed and other expenses necessary in the premises, payment for which shall be made upon vouchers approved by the duly authorized agent of said U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service in charge in the Territory. Such money shall be set apart in a special fund to be designated, "Predatory Animal Fund".

Section 3. Proceeds received from the sale of furs, skins and specimens taken by hunters whose compensation is paid out of

1 funds appropriated under this Act shall be covered into said fund
2 and be expended for the purposes herein set forth.

3 Section 4. If any section, provision, paragraph, clause, or
4 sentence of this Act is declared invalid, such decision shall
5 affect only the section, provision, paragraph, clause or sentence
6 so declared invalid.

7 Section 5. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict herewith
8 are hereby repealed.

9 Section 6. In the opinion of the Territorial Legislature
10 an emergency exists and this Act shall be in force and effect
11 from and after its passage and approval.
