6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to permit minors to operate motor  
7 bicycles"<sup>motor bicycles</sup>

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, or any rule or  
10 regulation of the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, to  
11 the contrary, licenses for the operation of motor bicycles<sup>motor bicycles</sup> may  
12 be issued to persons between the ages of thirteen and sixteen  
13 years with the consent of the parents or guardians. The term  
14 "motor bicycle" shall mean any bicycle<sup>motor bicycle</sup> that is self-propelled,  
15 but shall not include a motorcycle.

Section 3. Permits for operating motor bicycles or motor scooters may be revoked and penalties assessed in the same manner prescribed by law or regulation for violations in the operation of other motor vehicles.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
