SENATE BILL NO. 97

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to authorize the Employment Security Commission to acquire land and buildings for office space; amending Section 51-5-11 ACLA 1949; and declaring an emergency."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Section 51-5-11 ACLA 1949 is amended by adding thereto subsection (m) to read as follows:

(m) Acquisition of Land and Buildings. (1) The Commission is authorized to acquire for and in the name of the Territory by term purchase agreements such land and buildings upon such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Bureau of Employment Security of the United States, or such other Federal Agency as shall hereafter perform its functions, for the purpose of providing office space for the Commission at such places as the Commission shall find necessary and suitable.

(2) Any agreement made for the purchase of said premises shall be subject to the approval of the Attorney General as to form, and shall not subject the Territory to any liability for the payment of such purchase price, or any part or portion thereof, except from such moneys as may be allocated to the Territory by the Bureau of Employment Security, or successor thereto, for the administration of the Alaska Employment Security Law.

1 (3) All moneys received from the United States for
2 the payments authorized herein for such lands and buildings
3 shall be deposited in the Unemployment Compensation Ad-
4 ministration Fund in the Territorial Treasury and are hereby
5 appropriated therefrom for purposes of this Act.

6 (4) It is declared to be the policy of this Territory
7 that in the event such premises are purchased pursuant to
8 this Act, the Employment Security Commission, or such other
9 department of the Territory as may hereafter perform its
10 functions, shall be housed therein without further payment
11 therefor by the United States; or if, in the future, it may
12 be desirable to move said Employment Security Commission,
13 other suitable similar space will be furnished by the Terri-
14 tory to said Commission without further payment therefor
15 by the United States.

16 Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and
17 this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
18 approval.
