3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION.

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring certain designated  
7 inmates of the Pioneers' Home to  
8 contribute to their support and  
9 maintenance; and declaring an emergency."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Any inmate of or applicant for future admittance  
12 to the Pioneers' Home must meet the following conditions:

13 (1) Every such person must execute an affidavit  
14 enumerating all sources and amounts of income receivable,  
15 including any payments under the Social Security Act of the  
16 United States.

17 (2) Every such person, upon receipt of said income,  
18 shall tender to the Superintendent of the Home each month all  
19 amounts in excess of ~~\$15~~<sup>25</sup>.00, which said amounts shall be applied  
20 to defray, in whole or in part, his or her cost of maintenance  
21 at the Home.

22 Section 2. The failure or refusal to execute the above  
23 affidavit or the wilful making of any false statement therein  
24 shall constitute grounds for dismissal from the Home.

25 Section 3. All such payments received by the Superintendent  
26 of the Home shall be promptly transmitted to the Territorial  
27 Treasurer who shall cover the same into the General Fund.

28 Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and  
29 this Act shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
