6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to houses of ill fame;  
7 amending Section 65-9-13 ACLA 1949; and  
8 declaring an emergency."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Section 65-9-13 ACLA 1949 is hereby amended to  
11 read as follows:

12 Section 65-9-13. KEEPING BAWDYHOUSE. That if any  
13 person shall keep or set up a house of ill fame, brothel,  
14 or bawdyhouse for the purpose of prostitution, fornication,  
15 or lewdness, such person, upon conviction thereof, shall be  
16 punished by imprisonment in the county jail not less than  
17 three months nor more than one year, or by fine not less  
18 than one hundred nor more than five hundred dollars.

19 For the purposes of this Act a bawdyhouse shall be  
20 defined as any house, boat, ship or vessel, brothel, house  
21 of ill fame, or a house of prostitution or a room in any  
22 building whatsoever where prostitution, fornication or  
23 lewdness is carried on and the number of residents or  
24 frequenters thereto shall be deemed immaterial.

25 Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and  
26 this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and  
27 approval.
