6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the location of beverage
7 dispensaries and package liquor stores
8 in the Territory, and amending sub-section
9 (3) of Section 35-4-15 ACLA 1949." ^{add}

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sub-section (3) of Section 35-4-15 ACLA 1949
12 is amended to read as follows:

13 (3) Proximity to School or Church. No beverage dis-
14 pensary license or package liquor store license shall be
15 issued for the sale of any intoxicating liquor in any build-
16 ing within two hundred feet of any school (BUILDING) ground
17 or church building ^{measured} by shortest direct line from such school
18 ground or church building, (TO ANY SUCH BUILDING) within any
19 corporate municipality, nor within one quarter of a mile of
20 any school ground or church building where such school ground
21 or church building is located outside the corporate limits of
22 a municipality. (For the purpose of this section, an igloo,
23 serie, parlor or lodge of an American national fraternal
24 organization seeking a club license shall not be deemed to
25 be within the classification of a dispensary with respect to
26 proximity to a church. An American national fraternal or-
27 ganization as used in this section means only such organiza-
28 tions as function in not less than 36 States of the Union
29 and have not less than 300 local units in said 36 States,

and have been in active and continuous existence for 20 years. Provided, however, that a license may be reissued for the sale of intoxicating liquor in any building in which the sale of intoxicating liquor was at the time of the passing of this Act, ~~authorized by law.~~

Be it further provided, however, that when a license for the sale of intoxicating liquor in any building within 200 feet of a school (HOUSE) ground or church building, within the corporate limits of a municipality, or within a quarter of a mile, in areas outside the corporate limits of a municipality, is forfeited by reason of a violation of law, no license for the sale of intoxicating liquor on these premises shall thereafter be issued.
