6 For an Act entitled: "An Act pertaining to the regulation and
7 use of intoxicating liquors."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. No person shall sell, furnish, give or deliver
10 any intoxicating liquor, or permit the drinking thereof on any
11 premises licensed under Title 38, Chapter 4, ACLA 1949 as amended
12 between the hours of one o'clock A.M. and eight o'clock A.M. on
13 Mondays through Saturdays nor between one o'clock A.M. and one
14 o'clock P.M. on Sundays, except that establishments presenting
15 live entertainment for which there is paid the federal tax on
16 cabarets, roof gardens, etc., under the provisions of Section
17 1700, Chapter 10, United States Internal Revenue Code as amended,
18 may additionally sell, furnish, give or deliver and permit the
19 drinking of intoxicating liquor during the hours of one o'clock
20 A.M. and two o'clock A.M. Mechanical sound contrivances, mechani-
21 cal music, juke boxes, radios, sound units or devices, shall not
22 constitute live entertainment.
