A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act to provide for payment of Bounty deficiencies, and other sundry claims, and authorizing the Treasurer to waive certain provisions of the Bounty law."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:
