SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, drilling for production of oil in Alaska is

anticipated in the near future; and

8

WHEREAS, the oil-producing states of the United States of

9

America have found that maximum ultimate oil and gas production

10

is obtained by proper use of oil conservation measures; and

11

WHEREAS, the Interstate Oil Compact to Conserve Oil and

12

Gas and the Interstate Oil Compact Commission are an agreement

13

and an organization dedicated to the conservation of oil and

14

gas that will be of aid and benefit to Alaska in conservation

15

problems.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE

17

TERRITORY OF ALASKA: that the Governor of the Territory of

18

Alaska is hereby authorized and directed, for and in the name

19

of the Territory of Alaska, to join with other states in the

20

Interstate Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas, which was hereto-

21

fore executed in the city of Dallas, Texas, on the 16th day of

22

February, 1935, and is now deposited with the Department of

23

State of the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor of the Territory

25

of Alaska is further authorized and empowered, for and in the

26

name of the Territory of Alaska, to execute agreements for the

27

further extension of the expiration date of the said Interstate

28

Oil Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas, and to determine if and

29

when it shall be for the best interest of the Territory of

1 Alaska to withdraw from said Compact upon sixty days notice as
2 provided by its terms. In the event he shall determine that
3 the Territory of Alaska should withdraw from said Compact he
4 shall have full power and authority to give necessary notice
5 and to take any and all steps necessary and proper to effect
6 the withdrawal of the Territory of Alaska from said Compact.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor shall be the
8 official representative of the Territory of Alaska on Interstate
9 Oil Compact Commission, provided for in the Compact to Conserve
10 Oil and Gas, and shall exercise and perform for the Territory
11 of Alaska all the powers and duties as an associate member of
12 the Interstate Oil Compact Commission; provided, that he shall
13 have the authority to appoint an assistant representative who
14 shall act in his stead as the official representative of the
15 Territory of Alaska as an associate member of said Commission.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of the Resolution be
17 furnished the Governor of Alaska and to the Chairman and Secretary
18 of the Interstate Compact to Conserve Oil and Gas.
