6. Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska
7. respectfully represents;

8. WHEREAS, Section 1953 of Title 28, United States Code per-
9. mits a final judgment for the recovery of money or property
10. entered in any district court of the United States to be regis-
11. tered in any other such district court and therein enforced, with-
12. out the necessity for filing a suit thereon in such other
13. district court, and

14. WHEREAS, the provisions thereof do not apply to the United
15. States District Court for the Territory of Alaska, and

16. WHEREAS, it is necessary to file another suit in any
17. jurisdiction outside the Territory of Alaska to enforce a judgment
18. of the United States District Court for the Territory of Alaska,
19. and to file a suit in the Territory to enforce a judgment of a
20. district court of the United States, and

21. WHEREAS, such procedure causes unwarranted expense, delay
22. and obstruction to the administration of justice in Alaska;

23. NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the
24. Territory of Alaska, respectfully prays that Congress pass
25. H. R. 1976, 83d Congress, 3d Session, introduced by Delegate
26. Bartlett and thereby eliminate an unjust discrimination in the
27. administration of justice.
