5 TO THE GOVERNOR OF ALASKA, AND THE COMMISSIONER, DIRECTOR,  
6 CHIEF ADMINISTRATOR, OR OTHER OFFICIAL IN CHARGE OF EMPLOY-  
7 MENT IN EACH BRANCH, DEPARTMENT, AGENCY, BOARD OR ADMINISTRATION  
8 OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

9 Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of  
10 Alaska, in Twenty-first Session assembled, respectfully  
11 represents:

12 WHEREAS, there are approximately 1,500 persons employed  
13 by the various branches, departments and agencies of the Terri-  
14 torial Government in positions of differing types of employ-  
15 ment; and

16 WHEREAS, there are approximately 5,000 negro residents, and  
17 33,863 non-white native residents of the Territory of Alaska,  
18 many of whom are qualified for employment by the Territorial  
19 Government in its various positions with qualifications ranging  
20 from menial through the skilled and professional;

21 NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the Legislature of the  
22 Territory of Alaska, in Twenty-first Session assembled, respect-  
23 fully urges that those in charge of employment in the Territorial  
24 Government be ever on the alert to avoid any discrimination for  
25 reasons of race or color, in order that the practices of the  
26 Government of the Territory of Alaska may be an example of fair-  
27 ness in every way in the field of employment practices.
