TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES; THE SECRETARY OF THE

ARMY; THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES; THE CHIEF OF ARMY

ENGINEERS; AND THE DELEGATE TO CONGRESS FROM ALASKA:

Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska,

9

in twenty-first regular session assembled, respectfully

10

represents that:

WHEREAS, the City of Kodiak is the center of one of the most

12

important fishing and big game hunting areas in Alaska; and

13

WHEREAS, approximately four hundred fishing boats are in

14

use in the area, plus an unknown number of boats used in the big

15

game hunting industry of Kodiak Island; and

16

WHEREAS, fishing is the principal industry of the area and

17

supports the bulk of the population, and is the only natural

18

resource presently available in the area; and

19

WHEREAS, while big game hunting is presently a secondary

20

industry, its potential is unlimited; and

21

WHEREAS, there is not a small boat harbor for the protection

22

of the boats essential to these two industries and these valuable

23

boats are unprotected from the severe storms while moored in the

24

harbor at Kodiak with great damage resulting from the exposure to

25

such storms;

NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialist, the Legislature of the

27

Territory of Alaska, respectfully prays that the Congress of the

28

United States direct the Department of the Army and the Chief of

29

Army Engineers to construct a breakwater in the harbor at the

1 City of Kodiak and further that Congress make an appropriation  
2 for the construction thereof.
