2. SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2

3. IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4. TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

6. WHEREAS, the town of Kotzebue is a rapidly growing community
7. which is centrally located for the distribution of supplies and
8. the transportation of persons to outlying communities, is a tour-
9. ist attraction for thousands of travelers each season, and has
10. central hospital facilities for a large area, thus making an ade-
11. quate, safe water supply imperative; and

12. WHEREAS, the water supply in the immediate vicinity of the
13. town of Kotzebue has been condemned by Territorial Health authori-
14. ties as unsafe for human consumption, and test drilling for a new
15. water supply in the near vicinity has failed to produce any satis-
16. factory results; and

17. WHEREAS, it would be possible to secure a satisfactory water
18. supply from Sadie Creek, approximately seven miles distant from
19. the Town of Kotzebue, were a road to be built to this water
20. source; and

21. WHEREAS, equipment for road-building being presently avail-
22. able in Kotzebue, the cost of such a road would not exceed
23. \$55,000.

24. NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Legislature of the
25. Territory of Alaska that the Territorial Board of Road
26. Commissioners and the Highway Engineer take immediate steps
27. for the survey and construction of a road from the Town of
28. Kotzebue to Sadie Creek and expend the necessary monies for that
29. purpose from funds available for the construction of public roads.
