2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

4 TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

6 WHEREAS, the area in the Second Judicial Division south and  
7 north of Teller contains gold and many strategic minerals, including  
8 tin, and

9 WHEREAS, lack of proper road facilities has prevented the  
10 development of this area, and

11 WHEREAS, there is at present a road running fifteen miles  
12 south from Teller and a road known as the Sunset Road running  
13 ten miles north from Nome, with a missing link for a distance  
14 of forty-eight miles, and

15 WHEREAS, the development of the area will be retarded unless  
16 road facilities are furnished.

17 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory  
18 of Alaska, the House of Representatives concurring, that a road  
19 be constructed by the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners  
20 for a distance of approximately forty-eight miles, to connect the  
21 present road known as the Sunset Road running ten miles north  
22 of Nome, with the present road running fifteen miles south from  
23 Teller; that surveys be undertaken as expeditiously as possible,  
24 and that the road be constructed with all possible speed and  
25 according to Territorial standards.
