IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-FIRST SESSION

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

6 WHEREAS, the people of the Territory of Alaska have, by an
7 overwhelming referendum vote of 20,544 to 3,479, demanded that
8 they be given self-control of the fisheries of the Territory;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the present session of the Legislature has by unani-
11 mous vote passed House Joint Memorial No. 11 requesting that
12 the Congress of the United States in accordance with this mandate,
13 take immediate action to transfer control of the fisheries of
14 Alaska to the Government of the Territory of Alaska.

15 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Territory
16 of Alaska that the Delegate to Congress, the Statehood Committee,
17 and any other committee or board empowered to promote legislation
18 on behalf of the Territory in the United States Congress, are
19 requested to expend funds and directed to use their facilities and
20 effort to bring about the passage of any Federal legislation that
21 will accomplish the purpose of this mandate. The Delegate to
22 Congress is further requested to arrange for the proper witnesses
23 to come from Alaska to testify before the Senate and House Com-
24 mittees hearing this measure, and it is recommended that their
25 travel expenses be defrayed from the Governor's Emergency Fund
26 to the extent that it may be necessary.
