HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. *42*

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES IN EXTRAORDINARY
SESSION OF THE TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE ASSEMBLED, THE SENATE
CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, Almighty God, in his infinite wisdom, has called
Simon Hellenthal, one of Alaska's leading citizens for nearly
one-half a century to eternal rest; and

WHEREAS, the said Simon Hellenthal was a leading member of
the Bar of Alaska and was from ¹⁹³⁴⁻⁴³ 1934 to ⁴⁵ 1945 United States Federal
Judge for the Third Division of Alaska, in which position he
acquired widespread esteem and respect as an able, fair and con-
scientious jurist; and

WHEREAS, the people of Alaska have lost a distinguished
citizen and a loyal and faithful public servant and a true friend;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the House of Representa-
tives, the Senate concurring, that the members of the Extraordi-
nary Session of the Twenty-Second Legislative Session of the
Legislature of Alaska, aware of the great loss they and their
fellow citizens have sustained in the death of Hon. Simon
Hellenthal, hereby express their heart-felt sympathy to the widow
and son, and the brothers and sisters of the deceased, in this
their hour of sorrow.

It is further Resolved that this Resolution be duly engrossed
upon the Journals of both houses of the Legislature, and copies
thereof be forwarded to the members of the deceased's family.
