HOUSE MEMORIAL NO. *4*

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, THE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR, THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE AND THE SECRETARY OF STATE:

Your Memorialist, the House of Representatives in Extraordinary Session of the Twenty-second Legislature assembled, respectfully submits that:

WHEREAS, the Haines Highway, otherwise known as the Haines Cut-off, connects a tide water port with the Alaska Highway at a point 162 miles from Haines, and promises increasing economic development of the area through tourist, commercial and industrial uses, and should therefore be maintained as a year-around route; and

WHEREAS, the Haines Cut-off connection with the Alaska Highway provides an alternate route to tide water from Interior Alaska; and

WHEREAS, year-around utilization of Haines Highway would serve to bring about settlement and development of an area in the Territory which is rich in resources; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the Haines Cut-off and segment of the Alaska Highway which is within Canada requires that arrangements be made with the government of Canada to carry out the purpose hereof;

NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska, in Extraordinary Session of the Twenty-second Legislature assembled, respectfully urges that appropriate steps be taken with the Canadian government and with

2 year-around use of said Haines Highway.
