4 TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION
5 TO THE COMMANDING OFFICER, ELMENDORF AIR FORCE BASE; DISTRICT
6 ENGINEER, UNITED STATES ARMY; TERRITORIAL DIRECTOR OF CIVIL
7 DEFENSE; TERRITORIAL HIGHWAY ENGINEER AND MAYOR OF THE CITY OF
8 ANCHORAGE, ALASKA:

9 YOUR MEMORIALIST, the House of Representatives of the Terri-
10 tory of Alaska, in Extraordinary Session of the Twenty-second
11 Legislature assembled, respectfully represents;

12 WHEREAS, at least 25,000 cars per day pass the intersection
13 of Bragaw Street, Anchorage, Alaska, and the Glenn Highway; and

14 WHEREAS, there have been, during the past ten years, numerous
15 traffic accidents at said intersection, resulting in loss of life,
16 limb and valuable property; and

17 WHEREAS, in the event of evacuation said intersection, in its
18 present condition, would create an extremely dangerous situation,
19 and impede the movement of civilian and military personnel; and

20 WHEREAS, the surveying and necessary engineering work pre-
21 paratory to extending Bragaw Street to Elmendorf Air Force Base
22 has been completed; and

23 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the residents of the Anchorage
24 area to have Bragaw Street extended to Elmendorf Air Force Base;

25 NOW THEREFORE, your Memorialist, the House of Representatives
26 of the Territory of Alaska, in Extraordinary Session of the
27 Twenty-second Legislature assembled, respectfully urges that the
28 necessary steps be taken to commence work on the extension of
29 Bragaw Street, Anchorage, Alaska, to Elmendorf Air Force Base,

1 so that construction thereon may be completed on said extension
2 before the termination of the 1955 construction season.
