SENATE BILL NO. 3

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA

TWENTY-SECOND LEGISLATURE, FIRST EXTRAORDINARY SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing Legislative Districts for the election of members of the Territorial House of Representatives."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Legislature of the Territory of Alaska, acting under and by virtue of the power and authority granted in the Organic Act, do hereby establish the districts from which the members of the House of Representatives of the Territory of Alaska shall be elected, in accordance with the number of inhabitants, as herein set forth.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall consist of twenty-four members who shall be elected from thirteen representative districts herein established, and said representative districts are hereby created, constituted and numbered as follows:

FIRST JUDICIAL DIVISION

First Judicial Division shall be one District.

SECOND JUDICIAL DIVISION

The whole of the Second Division shall be one District.

THIRD JUDICIAL DIVISION

District No. 1. Kodiak, Aleutian Islands and Unga Peninsula Recording Districts.

District No. 2. Homer, Seldovia, Kvichak, Iliamna

tricts.

District No. 3. Cordova, McCarthy, Valdez,
Chitina, Talkeetna and Wasilla
Recording Districts, and that
portion of the Palmer Recording
District lying east of 149° W.
longitude.

District No. 4. Seward and Whittier Recording
Districts, that portion of
Anchorage Recording District
lying south of 61° N. latitude,
and that portion of Anchorage
Recording District lying west
of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. longitude.

District No. 5. That portion of Palmer Recording
District lying west of 149° W.
longitude and that portion of
Anchorage Recording District
lying north of $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. lati-
tude and east of $150^{\circ} 5'$ W. long-
itude.

District No. 6. That portion of Anchorage Re-
cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
W. longitude which lies south of
 $61^{\circ} 14'$ N. latitude and north of
 $61^{\circ} 13'$ N. latitude, but not
including any part of Anchorage city.

District No. 7. That portion of Anchorage Re-

1 cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
2 W. longitude which lies north of
3 $61^{\circ} N$, latitude and south of 61°
4 $11' N$, latitude.

5 District No. 8. That portion of Anchorage Re-
6 cording District east of $150^{\circ} 5'$
7 W. longitude which lies north of
8 $61^{\circ} 11' N$, latitude and south of
9 $61^{\circ} 13' N$, latitude but not in-
10 cluding any part of Anchorage city.

11 Districts Nos. 9 & 10. Anchorage city. (Two members
12 to be elected at large within the
13 city).

14 **FOURTH JUDICIAL DIVISION**

15 Fourth Judicial Division shall be one District.

16 Section 3. The representatives provided for in this Act
17 shall be nominated at the Territorial Primary Election of April,
18 1956, and at every Territorial Primary Election thereafter. The
19 representatives provided for in this Act shall be elected at the
20 general election to be held on the second Tuesday in October,
21 1956 and every two years thereafter.

22 Section 4. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict herewith
23 are hereby repealed.
